## 學校安全聯絡網 2 月份通訊

尊敬的校長閣下：

近年，互聯網上不時出現涉及賭博的網站，青少年很容易便通過網絡獲取博彩資訊，他們可能會抱着以小搏大的投機心態，或者視賭博為遊戲，因而忽視當中潛藏的危機。事實上，不法份子透過網絡非法開設博彩網站，吸引網民進行賭博，甚至藉此詐騙。

若青少年沉迷網絡賭博，不僅可能會墮入詐騙陷阱，亦會令他們迷失自我，變得意志消沉，失去學習的興趣，對日常生活造成深遠的影響。因此，本局在此建議校方及家長須多加留意青少年日常的生活，尤其是他們上網的習慣，如發現他們經常瀏覽與博彩相關的資訊或網站，應及時予以勸導；鼓勵青少年善用空餘時間，積極參與有益身心的課餘活動。同時，家長亦應以身作則，盡量避免和青少年討論與博彩有關的資訊，應適時向子女灌輸正確的價值觀，讓他們瞭解賭博的禍害，提升他們的拒賭能力，從而建立積極正向的生活態度。

### 青少年沉迷賭博的徵兆：

1. 經常無故缺課；
2. 學業成績轉差；
3. 經常向家人及朋友借錢或家居無故失竊；
4. 有時因缺錢而不進食；
5. 突然買一些奢侈品；
6. 不時跟人談及與賭博投注有關的資訊。

在此，本局呼籲青少年勿在好奇心驅使下嘗試網上賭博，如家長發現子女沉迷賭博活動，可先關心及瞭解情況，以及向防治賭博機構求助。如發現當中涉及犯罪行為，應立即向警方舉報。倘校方獲知任何犯罪訊息，可透過“學校安全聯絡網”聯絡機制或致電(8800 5500)、電郵([nam@pj.gov.mo](mailto:nam@pj.gov.mo))及傳真(2835 6895)等方式與關注少年組聯繫，校方所提供的所有犯罪訊息本局均會作保密處理。

## Safe School Network Bulletin (February 2021)

Dear Principal

Teenagers could easily have access to gambling information on the Internet these days. Some of them see gambling as a game that gives them fast money. Unfortunately they are not aware of the fact that fraudsters set up illegal gambling website with the intention to defraud them.

Addicted teenagers may seemingly become miserable in life and in their study. It is important that we pay close attention to our teenagers over their daily activities especially their surfing habits; give them guidance if they have been browsing gaming related sites and encourage them to take part in leisure activities beneficial for their well-being mentally and physically. Meanwhile, parents could explain the disadvantages of gambling to their children and instill them with the right values so that they can build up a positive attitude towards life.






### Risk factors for adolescent problem gambling:

1. Increased truancy;
2. Poor academic performance;
3. Borrowing money from family and friends a lot;
4. Household items or valuables always missing from home;
5. Not taking meals due to lack of money;
6. Spending more money on luxuries;
7. Constantly sharing gambling tips with others. °

The Judiciary Police urge teenagers to stay away from online gambling. If parents notice any signs of problem gambling among their children, try to find out the underlying reasons for their gambling and contact relevant support groups or institutions for help if needed.
